TRANSLATION AND TESTING OF THE TRAINING MODULES

12 training modules were elaborated by the U-Eco partners. These can be found on the U-Eco subpages of the partners' websites. They provided basic and deep knowledge regarding the linear and circular economy. The training modules were translated into the national languages of the project partners and tested with potential users, who were satisfied with the final result.

CIRCULAR CASE STUDIES AND GOOD PRACTICES

The second intellectual output of U-Eco is moving forwards! The consortium has conducted extensive research on national and international case studies and good practices within the 5 areas previously identified as the areas with the highest entrepreneurship potential in a circular economy context. As a result, the U-Eco consortium has selected 12 case studies and good practices both in the European and international scene. These case studies offer innovative examples of the reuse and recycling of materials and items, regenerative farming methods, unique water treatment and reuse methods, and green construction.
